Required Expenses

Tuition

Lunch and activity fees are included in tuition. Sports and most Visual and Performing Arts opportunities are included in tuition.

Payment Options

Chase offers three payment options.
Plan 1: One Payment - Net Tuition: Due June 1.
Plan 2: Two Installments - Net Tuition: 60% due June 1 and 40% due September 1.
Plan 3: Ten Monthly Installments: Due the First of every month May-February.

Deposits and tuition payments for the 2019-2020 school year will be made online through SmartTuition. A **non-refundable** 10% deposit is required at the time of enrollment. Both contract and deposit are required to complete the enrollment process and secure tuition and space in the school.

Technology

All students who enroll in Grades 6-12 are required to bring a family supplied laptop to school on a daily basis.

Books (Grades 6-12)

Textbooks are not included in the tuition and must be purchased separately. Information about ordering options will be sent at the time of course registration.

After School Program (Optional Service: Grades PreK-5)

Weekly Rate (Mon-Fri):	\$150

Private Music Lessons (Grades PK-12)

Each personalized lesson is 30 - 45 minutes and takes place during the academic day on Campus.

Cost per year:

Grades 1-12: \$1200 = approx. twenty-five 45 minute lessons
Pre-K and K: \$950 = approx. twenty-five 30 minute lessons

Visual Arts - Creative Study

The after school art workshop explore and apply methods and techniques in clay, paint/drawing, wood and mixed media.

Cost per year

Grades K - 8: \$385 = approx. 8 hour and a half group lessons

Additional Note: Additional fees for AP testing, lost library books, athletic equipment, special events, breakage/damage, etc. will be billed on your monthly statement as incurred.

Note: Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) insurance is required for families who do not pay the 2019-2020 tuition in full by June 1. TRP is 1.8% of the contract amount. For more information call the Business Office at 203-236-9586.

A \$40 late fee will be assigned by SmartTuition for any balances not paid by the due date.

A one time fee of \$50 will be charged if a family elects Plan 3, the 10 Payment Option.
